Synopsis

Con-Cierto Flamenco is an endearing and racial creation that captivates and dazzles.

Each of the artists shines with their own light in an overwhelming show devoid of group choreography, without a dance team.

The work is a novel, different, original proposal in lyrics, music and choreography, full of small allegories in which the protagonists provide **a** soundtrack to the feeling.



Farruquito revives the best moments of previous shows, integrating other passages anchored to essence and improvisation as indispensable hallmarks that tie him to the origins of 'lo jondo'.

It is configured as a **choreography of spontaneity** in the search for the wonderful balance between the different eras of flamenco that its dance has gone through, becoming the extension of music as a result of the extraordinary symbiosis of yesterday, today and tomorrow.

Flamenco singing, guitar, percussion and dance sway to the sound of other musical influences, clinging to **traditional roots** but with fresh shades of current rage.
